

The University of Texas at Arlington played a large part in collegiate club gymnastics. UT Arlington student Chuck Wilson was one of the Texas Gymnastics Conference's original founders in '79. The UT Arlington gymnastics club was active from then until the mid 90's when interest tapered off. In 2017 a group of students reformed the club at the University.

The UT Arlington team practices in an off campus facility space at ASI Gymnastics. Practice is from 8pm to 10pm Monday through Thursday throughout the year for the competitive team, and just Mondays and Wednesdays for the recreational team. Recreational membership costs \$200 and competitive membership is \$300 annually.

Membership is open to any UT Arlington student. Other Texas clubs that the team competes with include sister school UT Austin, Texas A&M University, Texas Tech, Texas State, Texas Christian University, Baylor, UT Dallas and the club gymnasts at the University of Oklahoma. The majority of the season's meets are hosted by each of these schools and the season is capped off with a national championship competition. The meets have a very relaxed and fun atmosphere.
